

IN GENERAL . . .

Coast Waste Management wants to make the collection of household waste as easy and convenient as possible for residents. For that reason, we ask you to comply with these requirements:

1. Adhere to 40-pound maximum weight for cans, bags and bundles.
2. Use standard 32-gallon or less garbage cans with lids.
3. Help your driver identify material by separating containers of trash, recyclables and yard waste on the curb for pickup by 7:00 AM.

REFUSE COLLECTION

Do Put Trash In ...

- Covered metal or plastic cans.
- Securely tied plastic trash bags.

DO NOT Put Trash In ...

- Cardboard boxes (flatten and tie in 3-foot long bundles; set along side recycling bin).
- Tubs or barrels.
- Waste baskets.

PLEASE NOTE

Containers with attached, hinged lids are not acceptable at this time. You will be notified when we are able to accommodate this type of container.



YARD WASTE COLLECTION

What Materials Will Be Collected?

- Grass and leaves
- Yard trimmings
- Untreated, unpainted lumber and wood waste
- Tree and shrubbery droppings less than 4 feet in length and 6 inches in diameter
- Unflocked, unsprayed Christmas trees devoid of metal ornamentation or stands

CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM

All residents of San Diego County, all of us must comply with ordinances mandating the separation of designated recyclables from normal refuse. These are:

- Newspaper • Aluminum Cans
- Plastic Beverage Containers
- Tin/Bi-metal Cans
- Glass Bottles/Jars • Yard Waste

Coast Waste Management provides two recycling bins for separation of these recyclable materials.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR COLLECTION

Metals: Scrap metals and auto parts
Glass: Vases, bakeware, drinking glasses, ceramic dishes, fluorescent light tubes
Plastic: Non beverage containers with recycling symbols 3-7, including plastic bags, black pottng containers, toys, laundry baskets, microwave dinner trays, butter tubs
Paper: Tissues, paper towels, paper plates, gun wrappers, waxed and coated papers.

Yard Waste ... It's not just a bunch of trash.

What Materials Cannot Be Collected?

- Earthen matter — dirt, rocks, concrete, etc.
- Animal waste
- Food remnants
- Decorated wood
- Material over 4 feet in length and 6 inches in diameter

GREEN BIN

Please rinse and remove caps and lids. No need to remove labels.



GLASS: All colors of beverage bottles (clear, amber and green), food jars (i.e. pickle jar).

ALUMINUM and TIN CANS: Aluminum beverage cans, tin cans (canned vegetable and soup cans).

PLASTIC: Plastic beverage containers with recycling symbols 1-7 (water, milk, soda, tea and juices), bottles containing household cleaners with recycling symbols 1 and 2 (shampoo, laundry detergent and window cleaners).



BLUE BIN

MIXED PAPER:

Newspaper, office paper (all colors), direct mail, envelopes, catalogs, phone books, magazines, paper bags, cereal and other cardboard boxes (boxes must be free from grease or food residue, and any plastic bags removed).

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD: When flattened and broken down into 3-foot long bundles, corrugated cardboard boxes may be placed at the curb line for recycling. Place the cardboard bundles along side the mixed paper container.

How To Participate ...

1. You are being supplied with two Yard Waste decals.
2. Affix the decal to the side of a trash container.
3. Place yard waste in this decal-designated container and in other approved containers or bundles as necessary.
4. NEVER place yard waste in plastic bags.
5. On collection day, place the decal-designated container facing the street, in front of any other yard waste containers.
